

COVID-19 Extensions

Per the Regional Flight Surgeon's office:

The following clarification is provided regarding the SFAR released on June 29, 2020:

The non-enforcement of expired medical certificates is a rolling 90-day action.

For example: The non-enforcement of medical certificates expiring on 30 March ends on 30 June 2020.

Medical certificates expiring between now and 30 September will not be enforced for 90 days... So if your medical certificate expires 31 May, you will have until 31 August... If it expires 30 September, you will have until 31 December.
